Please be aware that some courses have pre-requisites. You will not be admitted to these courses unless to meet the requirements.

Please be aware that there might be a collision in the time table, your course plan can easily be changed. It is therefore important that you choose more subjects than you need. Please remember to communicate with your study consultant in order to make a good plan for your stay. Students can not expect to get a final clarification what courses they are admitted to before arriving to the United States. It is important that quickly after arrival get a confirmation by CSULA what courses you have been admitted to.

Guidance:

Click on: "Essential Links".

Click on: "Class Schedule (Online)".

Select Subject: you can click on this button and then choose the subject area in which you are interested. For Example: "Accounting" = ACCT

(Course Number: Leave this alone – it is populated with "exactly" and then a box to enter a number. Just leave it as it is. You do not need to erase anything. Later, if you know the course number, you can easily bring it up from entering the number. For now, leave this alone because you want to see all the courses.)

Course Career: This is handy in case you want to search only "Undergraduate" classes (or it could be done for "Graduate" as well). In the drop-down box, click on "undergraduate. This clarification will return results that are only categorized as undergraduate-level classes.

Uncheck "Show Open Classes Only". This will allow you to see all the classes that are offered – not just the ones that have seats available. Then, click "Search". You should then see a list of classes offered for the Semester you have chosen. Right now, only Fall 2017 is showing. Spring 2018 will probably be available a little bit later on in the summer months.
